We will use our voices to speak up for ourselves.


Responsibility: We know it is important to be reliable and trustworthy, so people know they can count on us. We make thoughtful decisions and take ownership of our actions and words.

Holocaust Memorial Day

We were invited by Tamworth Borough Council to take part in a Holocaust Memorial Day project, organised by the Holocaust Memoria Day Trust and the Royal Horticultural Society. Plants are used as a symbol of remembrance and remind us of the importance of unity, peace and friendship.

We were given two planters to decorate and plant up. Each child in year 6 designed, drew and coloured a symbol related to peace, equality and happiness and added it to the planter. I hope you will agree how wonderful they look.

The children engaged well with the project and made great links to topics they have studied during their time at Two Gates in History, RE and PSHE - especially World War 1 and World War 2 and the lives of people affected by genocide such as Anne Frank.



The planters take pride of place in the reception area of our school and some of our year 6 children now have the very important job of watering and taking care of the plants and bulbs.

World Book Day 2024 is on Wednesday 6th March.

Children may come to school **dressed up** as their favourite book character; there will be a small prize for the best costume in each class!

Our book focus this year is 'The Paperbag Prince' by Colin Thompson. All classes will complete activities based on the text during the day. They will all bring home a free book on the day.




