Paris - March 2025

Following a few very successful trips with our Yr6 children and our partner schools within ATLP, I am delighted to be able to offer your child the opportunity to take part in the Y6 Paris visit. This will take place from 10th to 14th March 2025. This will be the 13th Two Gates visit to Paris.

The children will be collected by coach from Tamworth in the early hours of Monday morning and travel to France, arriving early evening. We return to school at approximately 7.00 pm on the Friday.

The trip will be led by Mrs Norton (ATLP Strategic Primary Lead) and Mrs Llewelyn-Cook (Head Teacher at Two Gates Primary School) in conjunction with PGL Travel Ltd, a first-class operator with a solid reputation for organising school trips - a reputation built up from over 60 years' experience in the school travel business. All PGL centres are regularly assessed by the relevant regulatory bodies within the industry and are operated to the highest standards. They are backed by ABTA membership and are ATOL licensed ensuring that all payments made are fully insured.

The children will be accommodated in a converted chateau on the outskirts of the city. The chateau was formerly a 3 star hotel and was used as the training camp for the Brazilian National football team when they were preparing for the World Cup. During their time in Paris the children will -

- Visit Sacre Coeur and the Artists' Quarter
- Have a trip up the Eiffel Tower
- Enjoy a tour of The Stade de France
- Have a boat ride along the Seine
- See other major sites in the city
- Visit Chateau de Fontainebleau
- Enjoy a full day excursion at Euro Disney
- Visit Vimy Ridge War Memorial if Tunnel times allow And...
- Enjoy organised evening activities at the Chateau



The estimated full cost of the visit is £595.00 per child which is **excellent value** considering that this includes travel, insurance, accommodation and meals at the Chateau, all activities and a hoodie and cap for each child. The only additional cost will be passport and pocket money (110 euros maximum) and meals en-route (£10 for UK stop off and 15 Euros for France stop off on the outbound journey. £15 on return journey).

If you would like your child to take part in the trip, please complete the Microsoft form (link below) and make an initial deposit of £50.00 on ParentPay by 19th April 2024.

*The full deposit is £160 per child, but we realise that this is a large amount to ask for by April 19th. We will therefore outlay the full deposit on your behalf. Both the remainder of the deposit and cost of the trip will need to be paid by yourselves -see payment schedule below.

Please be aware that the deposit of £160 is non- refundable, so if you make your initial payment of £50, you are committing to a non-refundable deposit of £160

This initial payment will be followed by 8 monthly instalments of £62.50 and a final balance payment of £45. The final Balance will be due 17th January 2025 but if you wish to make additional interim payments, you are more than welcome to do so.
