




On Wednesday, they gave a powerful and memorable performance of Matilda the Musical which delighted their peers, parents and families.

Cost of Living Update

In 2022, 15.04% of households in Tamworth - Jun 24 were living in fuel poverty. This is higher than the proportion in 2018, with then 8.79% of households in fuel poverty.

(Switch Data) The average Tamworth inhabitant household consumes 3,573.05 kWh a year.

An average Tamworth household will pay approximately £3,549 a year. The average spend on food for one person is around £44 per week (£189 per month).

In Tamworth - Jun 24, there are 97.92 prepay meters for every 1,000 households. Tamworth has a food insecurity index rating of 12,455 this means that Tamworth has a higher rate of food insecurity than England average and higher than the Staffordshire average






