

Maths:

- * **Adding and subtracting:** within 20
- * Finding number bonds to 20 - eg $17 + 3 = 20$.
- * Subtract and add by using a number line.
- * Solving word problems related to addition and subtraction.
- * **numbers to 50:** counting to 50
- * We will be identifying the tens and ones in a number eg $32 = 3$ tens and 2 ones.
- * Comparing numbers to 50 using $<$ $>$ and $=$ signs.
- * **Length and height**
- * Using non - standard units to measure length and height - e.g cubes
- * Measuring using a ruler in centimetres.
- * Solving word problems related to length and height.



English:

- * Our focus books are The Jolly Postman and Traditional Tales - The Three Little Pigs and Little Red Riding Hood
- * We will be using traditional story language in our writing - E.g Once upon a time.
- * Children will describe the characters and settings and develop new vocabulary.
- * We will be writing our own traditional tale by adapting the tale of 'The Three Little Pigs'.
- * Our writing focus will be on capital letters, full stops and finger spaces in our writing.
- * We will continue to learn how to spell some of the Y1 Common Exception Words.
- * All children will be encouraged to use phonics and Fred Fingers to spell words with increasing accuracy.
- All children will take part in daily Read, Write Inc phonics lessons. Children will also read texts matched to their phonic ability ' increase fluency and accuracy as well as develop their comprehension skills through guided reading.



PSHE and R.E

- * In PSHE we will be learning about our local community. The children will be encouraged to think about their local area and explain what they like about living in Tamworth and describe how they would improve where they live.
 - * In RE children will find out about ceremonies in which special moments in a person's life are marked. They will be able to discuss and describe what happens before and during these celebrations.
- Through PSHE and RE, children will develop the British Value of Individual Liberty, understanding how their choices can affect others and Respect and Tolerance.**

Geography:

- * We will be finding out where Africa is by locating it on a map.
- * We will be learning about what life is like in Kenya.
- * We will be finding out about the differences and similarities between Kenya and Tamworth.



Art:

- * We will be using clay to create a piece of art work.
- * We will be using a variety of clay tools to create different textures on our clay structures.

Ways in which you can help your child at home:
