

This term we are focusing on our 'Sense of Belonging' school value.

In Maths, children will learn how to:

- Use visual representations to show their understanding of addition and subtraction of fractions (bar models).
- Convert improper fractions to mixed numbers, in order to add and subtract.
- Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator.
- Add and subtract fractions where a common denominator is required.
- Complete word problems containing fractions and mixed numbers.
- Multiply fractions and mixed numbers by a whole number.

In Reading, children will learn how to:

- Retrieve vocabulary from the text, specifically related to bravery and perseverance.
- Comment on how the layout of the text can support our inferences and understanding of the various character points of view.

In Writing, children will learn how to:

- Write a newspaper article, relating to the story 'Wonder', adopting the style of a newspaper.
- Consider a journalistic point of view, collecting facts and opinions through witness statements.
- Revise grammatical aspects of a newspaper, such as the inclusion of both direct and indirect speech.

In Geography, children will learn about:
