- Measure angles with a protractor.

- Reason about 3D shapes.
- Use co-ordinates to reflect and translate a shape.
- Problem solve using metric and imperial units.
- Measure capacity.

- Use chronological order to write about a sequence of events.
- Explore and evaluate a range of poetic devices, giving reasons for their opinion.
