

This term we are focusing on our 'Sense of Belonging' school value.

In Maths, children will learn how to:

- Perform mental calculations, including with mixed operations and large numbers
- Identify common factors, common multiples and prime numbers
- Use estimation to check answers to calculations and determine, in the context of a problem, an appropriate degree of accuracy.
- Use common factors to simplify fractions; use common multiples to express fractions in the same denomination.

In Reading, children will learn how to:

- Maintain positive attitudes to reading and an understanding of what they read by continuing to read and discuss an increasingly wide range of fiction, poetry, plays, non-fiction and reference books or textbooks.

In Writing, children will learn how to:

- Evaluate and edit by proposing changes to vocabulary, grammar and punctuation to enhance effects and clarify meaning
- Draft and write by selecting appropriate grammar and vocabulary, understanding how such choices can change and enhance meaning

Other information:

HOMEWORK (Set every Friday): Pupils will be set a homework activity to complete by the following Friday centred around their maths, English or art learning.

SPELLINGS (Set every Monday): Spellings are available weekly on SeeSaw. Please encourage them to practice these.

READING: Please support your child with their home reading book, alongside signing of the reading record weekly. Books will be changed every Friday.

In History, children will learn about:

- How historians can identify information from 800 years ago.
- How crimes and punishments have changed between 1500 and 1750.
- Why so many changes took place in the 19th Century.

In Art, children will learn about:
