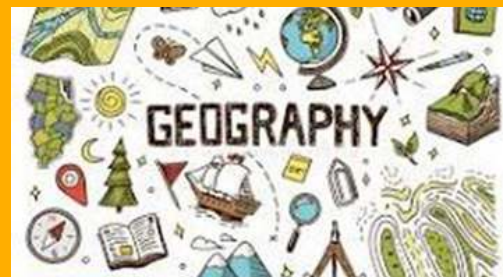

We shall be visiting school on Tuesday 10th October 2023 to deliver the Nasal Flu spray programme to those pupils in Reception - Year 6.
